

Laerskool Lorraine vereer hulle eie 'Queen of Music'

DIE Laerskool Lorraine se jaarlikse musiekkonert was hierdie jaar iets besonder toe die orkes Juffrou Lilian Koers vereer het vir haar jarelange diens.

Die konsert, wat op 3 November plaasgevind het, het Juffrou Koers in die kollig geplaas by haar 38ste konsert by Laerskool Lorraine.

Sy het die orkes in 1984 oorgeneem by Elize van Rooyen. Nou, reeds 38 jaar later, is die enorme impak opmerklik wat Lilian Koers se musiek op die gemeenskap gehad het.

Die bekende sanger Emo Adams het 'n paar jaar gelede saam met KykNET die skool besoek. Adams wat oral deur Suid-Afrika toer het opgemerk dat hy nog nie voorheen beleef het wat Juffrou Koers met die kinders regkry nie. Hy het later teruggekeer na Laerskool Lorraine om vir 'n konsert saam met die bekwame blaasorkes.

Koers se destydse musiek studente se kinders is nou al in die blaasorkes. Een van die leerlinge wat al jare 'n pad met dié juffrou en die orkes stap, is Michael Swart, die huidige Onderhoofseun vir 2022. Michael het sy eerste musiekkonert bygewoon nog voor sy eerste verjaarsdag aangesien beide Michael se ouer broers ook voormalige lede van die blaasorkes is. Vandeesmaand het Michael, as trotse orkes lid, sy dertiende konsert onder leiding van Juffrou Koers bygewoon!

Wat hierdie jaar se graad sewes uniek maak, is dat hulle die instrumente waarmee hulle by die konsert opgetree het, eers in Januarie 2020 begin leer het. Vir twee jaar het Koers dié groep kinders via WhatsApp touwys gemaak. Hulle het slegs vir twee maande lesse van aangesig tot aangesig gehad en steeds 'n uitmuntende konsert
